- List references that can attest to your job-related qualifications.
- Answer all application questions fully and honestly. Omitting or falsifying information that misrepresents your candidacy is prohibited.

What happens after I file my application?

Applications and resumes received will be sent to the Hiring Manager where they will be evaluated and a decision made as to which applicants to select for interviews. The volume of applications received varies per job so the amount of time may vary for the screening process.

Applications and resumes are only accepted for vacant positions and are reviewed as they are received. Phone calls are made only to those applicants that are chosen for interviews after being reviewed by the Department Manager.
